As we begin Spring semester, I want to update you on our search for the next Chancellor of the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA). Our search will be national in scope, and it is my intent to hire a chancellor who is deeply committed to and interested in the future of Alaska. I expect to make the appointment no later than the end of April, with that person starting over the summer.

Our process will be transparent, participative, and deliberate with ample opportunity for input. We initially posted the position on our online job search tool on December 23, 2020, and have already received 17 applications from international, national, and local candidates.

I have appointed a search committee that will be tri-chaired by Aleesha Towns-Bain, Executive Director of the Bristol Bay Native Corporation Education Foundation; Kelly Smith, UAA Faculty Senate President; and Preston Simmons, Chief Executive Providence Alaska Region.
